ELDERLY NUTRITION PROGRAMS

Home-Delivered Meals (Meals On Wheels) Persons over 60, the spouse of an eligible participant, and certain disabled persons under 60, may qualify for meals home-delivered up to five times a week. Donations are invited. *Senior Meals:* Hot meals served in a social setting in many towns in the region, anywhere from daily to several times, a month to Vermonters over 60 and their spouse of any age, plus certain others. Donations are invited.
