The Mobile Home Project (MHP) works with mobile home park residents and potential mobile homeowners throughout the state of Vermont. We believe that mobile homes provide an important affordable home ownership opportunity for Vermonters.

Our mission is:

“To give mobile home park residents greater control over their housing, through organizing and education, in order to protect and improve their housing rights and living conditions.”

We help residents work for better living conditions in their parks. Working with various agencies the MHP helps mobile home park residents assert their rights and understand their responsibilities under mobile home statutes. We help residents organize and maintain resident associations, respond to park sale and park closure notices, provide housing counseling to individuals, and work to ensure that mobile home park residents have a voice in the laws and agencies that affect their lives.
